Introduction

The Dome Theater at the National Museum of Emerging Science and Innovation (Miraikan) has two ultra-bright projectors with 40,000 lumens and 3D glasses to project bright and vivid images. The dome is also equipped with an 8.1-channel sound system that supports simultaneous playback of multiple sources (with picture-in-picture functionality) and video input via HDMI.

External Video Input

By connecting an HDMI-equipped device, you can project the image of the connected device at any location on the dome. It is also possible to input video in the Dome Master format and to project other videos at the same time.

*1 There is one input port on the console and one in the southwest corner of the dome. It is also possible to connect directly from the server room.

*2 Resolution @ Frame Rate

For special resolutions such as 3840 x 3840, 2800 x 2800, etc., you will need a computer with a graphics board as Geforce etc.

*3 If you want to play back multi-channel audio in stereo or above, see "External Audio Input" in the next section.

If you have two ports of simultaneous audio inputs, both will be played back.

External Audio Input

As of April 2020, the mixer has two stereo ports and two mono ports for a total of six channels. There is also an 8-channel input rack, which provides 8 channels of input.

The inputs to the mixer and the 8-channel input rack are the XLR male connectors (on the cable side).
